WORTH THE WAIT

After a few years of marriage, Misty and Kenneth Wethington wanted to start a family of their own. They have a special connection to adoption and knew they wanted to adopt after learning they couldn't have children. "My husband's grandmother was adopted, and she always spoke of how much love she received and the sense of family and belonging," said Misty. They wanted to provide that same feeling to a child waiting for a family to call their own. Their journey was slightly longer than anticipated, but with support and patience, one that came together beautifully.



In December of 2013, a little over three years after starting their adoption journey, Misty and Kenneth received a phone call from CPS in Lubbock. At the recommendation of their Spaulding for Children case manager, Jo Chevalier, the couple was being considered for adoptive placement with a 3-year-old boy named Matthew.



In January, Misty and Kenneth got on the road to Lubbock for a meeting that would change their lives. Misty remembers vividly, "The door opened and this beautiful little boy ran straight to Kenneth giving him the biggest hug, saying 'Daddy! Daddy!' That was it: we fell completely in love with him and knew he was meant to be our son." A week later Matthew went home with the couple, and this August they officially became a forever family.

Spaulding for Children is a participating charity of AmazonSmile. This is an easy way to designate a percentage of your purchase to go to Spaulding for Children!

Here is how it works:

- Head to <http://smile.amazon.com/>
 - Sign in as you would on your regular account or create one if you don't already have one
 - On your first visit to AmazonSmile, you will need to select Spaulding for Children to receive donations from eligible purchases before you begin shopping. You can do that by clicking the link towards the top of the page that reads "Supporting"
